(1) As every pop-psychologist knows, denial is the first stage of coming to terms with death. 'Among the over 200 dying patients we have interviewed,' writes Elisabeth Kubler-Ross in her classic work *On Death and Dying*, 'most reacted to the awareness of a terminal illness at first with the statement, "No, not me, it cannot be true."' Apparently, patients then move on, over a period of months, to anger, bargaining, depression and finally acceptance.
